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Anne Dotter was present to represent courses in Honors. The new course, HON 170: Honors Contract, replaces the old method of 1 credit hour contracts with a new standardized HON contract course and processes. Updates to HON 100 include updates to the course description, objectives, outline, and methods of evaluation of competencies. Several committee members expressed concern over possible unintentional curricular cross-over with ENGL 122. HON 250 is being updated to HON 270 due to the change in course repeatability business practice.

The committee discussed tabling HON 100 for further edits in order to have time to differentiate the course from ENGL 122. Matthew Schmeer motioned to table HON 100 and Tonia Hughes seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The committee motioned to approve HON 170, and the change from HON 250 to HON 270. Nick Mancini seconded the motion and the motion passed.
